6) Matters Arising 20/024

- i. Update on new Chorley Boundary signage. The manufacturer has completed the signs and CPC will pay the balance at this meeting. Signs to be shipped and installed late March / early April.
- ii. Accident data Knutsford Road. Cllr Durbar will discuss with CE highways officer N. Maltese at their meeting.
- iii. Ownership of issues raised (tabulated at end of minutes?). Action points to be tabulated at end of minutes.
- iv. Update on cemetery gatehouse. Cllr McFarlane reported that there was no new news about this; Cllr Browne has ideas about ongoing use for the property which is currently confidential.
- v. Cllr Barraclough enquired as to paperwork and meeting dates for the Lindow Trust. Cllr Durbar agreed that he would attempt to get hold of this information and pass onto Cllr Barraclough.
- vi. Cllr Barraclough noted that the next Parish Council Cluster meeting will be held on 16th April. Cllr M Dudley-Jones (AEPC) has invited some speakers along including Cllr Craig Browne, Sgt Lynsey Jackson and Cllr Suzie Akers-Smith. Noted that AEPC do a newsletter and CPC have been offered a page in the June newsletter, this will be distributed to Chorley residents as well. The full page can be a Chorley newsletter. Cllr Durbar enquired as to whether AEPC would allow CPC to insert a small article into the March newsletter concerning vacancies for new CPC councillors.

7) Highways Issues 20/025

- i. Consolidated List attached as a separate spreadsheet. Updated
- ii. To receive a report from Cllr Goldsmith regarding his meeting with CE Highways officer re: Knutsford Road. This meeting with CE Highways officer N Maltese has now been rearranged for 19th March at 8:45am Cllr Durbar will attend with Cllr Goldsmith and invited all other councillors along.
- iii. Update on Chorley Street Lighting. Noted that CE Highways have attended Knutsford Road and replaced all four old concrete columns with new steel columns with the new LED heads. The two pole brackets on Gore Lane were confirmed to have also had their new LED heads installed. The only items of street lighting which are now outstanding are the four pole brackets along Chelford Road which require new LED heads; this will require CE Highways traffic management during the upgrade. The clerk has written to Highways to request an update on a timeline for this to take place.
 - Councillors were in agreement that the clerk now approaches ENW with the new LED bulb wattages and update the inventory to the new lower wattages which should reduce the unmetered electricity supply bill for the Parish Council.
 - Councillors were also agreed that the clerk now approach CE Highways and CEC with a view to discussions over CECs adoption of the Chorley street lighting now it has been brought in line with the necessary standards.
- iv. Flooding on Foden Lane Noted that the flooding on Foden Lane has been an ongoing issue and has been raised with CE flood risk team. Areas of flooding have increased recently (road has had to be closed on occasion). Also noted that because of the flooding several large potholes have now formed and a sink hole has also opened up on the south side of the bridge over the brook. The clerk will attempt to raise works orders and liaise with the CE LHO regarding these items.
- v. Flooding at Brook Lane Roundabout. Cllr McFarlane noted that this work had been completed; Cllr Durbar was unsure whether it had or not, as the area still seemed prone to flooding in the heavy rain. Both councillors will continue to monitor the situation.
- vi. Cllr Durbar noted that UU had recently fixed a reported leak at the corner of Dingle Avenue, however the leak was still continuing.
- vii. Cllr Durbar noted a blocked grid at the South end of Dingle Avenue which he has reported to CE Highways.
